**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG**

Mayor Harrell called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. After the call to order, Mayor Pro Tem Waddell gave the invocation and all those assembled pledged allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR SESSION – September 19, 2006**

Upon motion by Alderman Palmer, seconded by Alderman Sweet, and unanimously carried, the Council in a 6-0 decision approved the minutes of the regular session held September 19, 2006.

**ACTION ON REQUEST FROM THE FIRST FLINT RIVER MISSIONARY  
BAPTIST ASSOCIATION – PLACEMENT OF HISTORICAL MARKER ON  
HUTTO MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMPUS**

City Manager Hobby explained the First Flint River Missionary Baptist Association is desirous of placing a historical marker along public right-of-way adjacent to Hutto Middle School to mark the location of an 1890's vintage school that was operated by this organization on this site. The city's role would be to approve the use of public right-of-way and to assist with the selection of the site of the marker. Upon motion by Mayor Pro Tem Waddell, seconded by Alderman Palmer, and unanimously carried, the Council in a 6-0 decision to approve the request of the First Flint River Missionary Baptist Association of placement of historical marker adjacent to the right-of-way of Hutto Middle School.

**ACTION ON REQUEST FROM FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH –  
STREET CLOSURE ON OCTOBER 13, 2006**

City Manager Hobby explained the request submitted by First United Methodist Church. Area churches rotate hosting a youth event following home Bainbridge High School Football games. On October 13<sup>th</sup> the Methodist Church will host this event and has requested that Florida Street be closed from Shotwell to Troupe Street from 10 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. in order to accommodate their planned activities and provide the safest possible venue. Upon motion by Alderman Conyers, seconded by Alderman Reynolds, and unanimously carried, the Council in a 6-0 decision to approve the street closure on October 13, 2006 for the First United Methodist Church.

**ACTION ON REQUEST FROM MAINSTREET DEPARTMENT – STREET  
CLOSURE ON OCTOBER 31, 2006**

City Manager Hobby stated this request is city generated request for street closure. The city will again be hosting a variety of Halloween activities in Willis Park on Tuesday, October 31, 2006 from 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. In order to accommodate this event we will need to close West Street from Broughton to Water Street during this time. Upon motion by Alderman Conyers, seconded by Alderman Palmer, and unanimously carried, the Council in a 6-0 decision to approve the street closure on West Street from Broughton to Water Street during 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on October 31, 2006, with the city notifying each business on West Street in person.
